Why? All of our projects are assessed on a case-by-case basis and provision of tech providers is based on a best-fit basis.
- Do not use the logo without consent.
Why? It is essential that you request use of the logo stating it's intended use via email to madesmartermarketing@growthco.uk,
- Do not reproduce Made Smarter graphics.
Why? All Made Smarter assets and graphics remain the ownership of Made Smarter.
- Do not create or adapt our case studies.
Why? All our case studies are delivered in conjunction with the SME beneficiary and only released publicly following their explicit consent.
