It will give you the skills, confidence and motivation to implement successful digital strategies across your business to enhance productivity, sustainability, excellence and customer satisfaction.

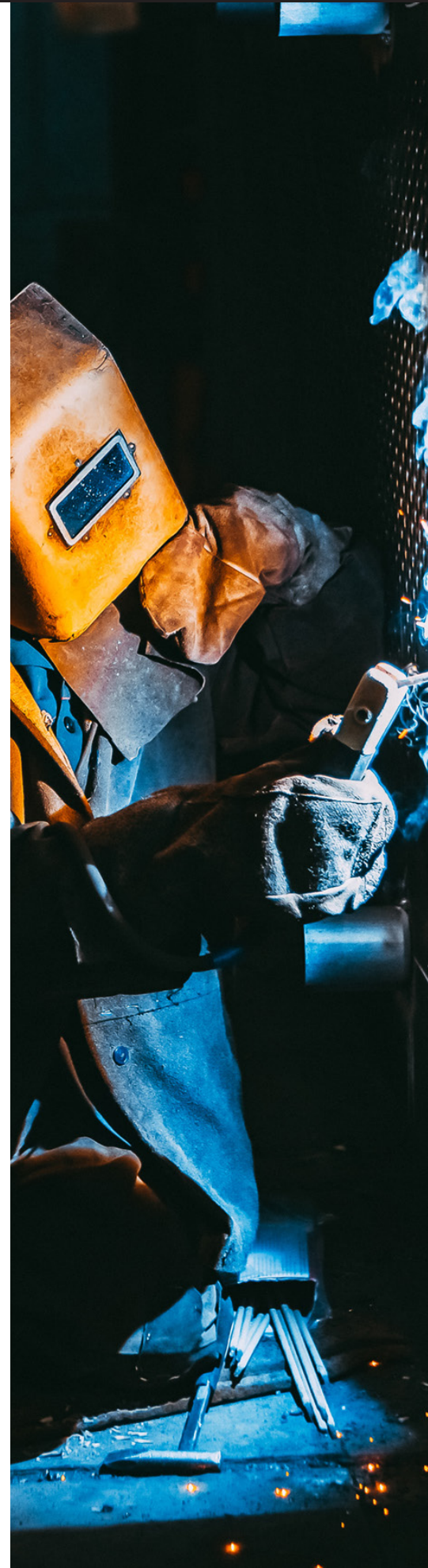

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Who is the course for?

- Employ between 5 and 249 employees

The course will support you to deliver digital change across your business, however, you'll need to commit the time and energy to apply your skills in practice.

- 40 hours of leadership training across 12 weeks

Applied Learning

The course is highly applied and is focused on your development as a leader of digital transformational change in the manufacturing sector.

Your Development Consultant tutor will build a strong relationship with you as you proceed through the course. They will get to know you and will support, coach and, where appropriate, challenge you to help you learn and apply the course concepts.

We'll support and encourage you to reflect and apply the learning to your firm from the very beginning of the course. As each workshop proceeds, you will gain a deeper understanding of the concepts and how they can apply to your business.

Our goal is to help you develop - by workshop 9 - a credible productivity action plan which will specify the business and marketing rationale, the process, people and system changes needed and the business case justification.

Following a two month gap which gives you time to pilot, test or embed your new solution, we will re-group in workshop 10 for a Holding to Account Workshop. This will give you a clear focus and the opportunity to share insights with your peers.
